What Parents think could be better

- ▶ Too many non-school uniform days in a term. We are trying to plan these ahead however we enjoy taking part in fundraising events.
- ▶ Healthier food at ASP and Breakfast club – review to take place
- ▶ Parking – it is unsafe.
- ▶ I would like some homework for the children – daily reading and daily times tables. September review for Years 5/6

- Better communication between parents and teachers
- More feedback regarding my child's progress
- Children's houses changing every year
- Communications. One method would be better e.g. email or dojo
- More notice for trips
- Shuffle up day, parents would like to know which class children are in
- Digital method for what money is owed
- Some staff can come across as 'shouty' even when children walk straight into school
